The Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 475, entitled "Taxation," is hereby amended through the creation of a new Article XII, entitled "Sheriff's Sales," and comprised as follows: Article XII

Sheriff's Sales

§475-60. Recording of deeds and notification of Sheriff's sales to taxing bodies. A. B. At the time of the sale the Sheriff shall collect all requisite filing costs, realty transfer taxes and fees necessary to properly record the deed.

C. Within seven days of receipt of written notice from the Sheriff, the Allegheny County Office of Property Assessments shall forward copies of such notice to all taxing bodies levying real estate taxes on the property described, including but not limited to the municipality and school district where the property is located. AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 14 OF ACT

NO. 77 OF 1986. THE COST OF ALL DOCUMENTARY STAMPS FOR REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAXES (STATE, LOCAL, AND SCHOOL) WILL BE DEDUCTED BY THE SHERIFF FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE.
