No. 23 WM 2020

ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 24th day of February, 2021, pursuant to Pa.R.J.A. No. 1952(B)(2), this Court having declared a judicial emergency in the Fifth Judicial District of Pennsylvania through June 30, 2021, recognizes that rent assistance through the Emergency Rental Assistance Program and other programs is available for landlords and tenants in Allegheny County and that landlords and tenants may require time to apply for such assistance and additional time for their applications to be processed. This Court further recognizes that on September 4, 2020, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued an Order temporarily halting certain evictions nationwide to prevent further spread of COVID-19, which has been extended through March 31, 2021. Therefore, the following is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED.

Residential landlord tenant actions will be accepted for filing within the Fifth Judicial District pursuant to the applicable statutes and rules governing those actions subject to the restrictions in this Order and the CDC Order.

I. Applicable Procedures When CDC Order Does Not Apply

The procedures below apply to those residential landlord tenant actions at a Magisterial District Court where the action is based, at least in part, on nonpayment of rent or end of lease and where the CDC Order is not applicable to the matter.

1. Initial hearing dates for residential landlord tenant actions filed at the Magisterial District Courts where the action is based, at least in part, on nonpayment of rent or end of lease, shall be scheduled at the latest available landlord tenant court date consistent with Pa.R.C.P.M.D.J. 504 and may be scheduled up to thirty (30) days beyond the time limit set forth in Rule tion to be processed. Multiple continuances may be granted to allow for sufficient time for the application to be processed and the rent relief to be provided. A hearing shall not occur while good faith efforts are being made to obtain assistance that would be reasonably likely to satisfy a potential judgment under Pa.R.C.P.M.D.J. 518.

5. If, at the status conference, it is determined that the case involves an end-of-lease situation in which the payment of money would not prevent an eviction and the tenant would not be able to satisfy a potential judgment under Pa.R.C.P.M.D.J. 518 by the payment of money, the case shall be continued for a period of time of between 21 and 35 days. The Allegheny County Department of Human Services and/or other agencies will provide information and resources to assist tenants in planning for alternative housing arrangements in the event of a potential judgment in favor of the landlord.

8. Landlord-tenant proceedings may be conducted by ACT, provided both parties are given the opportunity to communicate with Allegheny County Department of Human Services personnel to discuss rental assistance and available resources. In-person hearings are also permitted.

II. Applicable Procedures When CDC Order Does Apply

The procedures in this section apply to residential landlord tenant actions at a Magisterial District Court or the Court of Common Pleas where the tenant complies with the requirements of the CDC Order.

Prior to accepting a new residential landlord tenant action for filing, the Court shall require a landlord to sign an affidavit stating whether or not they have received a Declaration Form from the tenant pursuant to the CDC Order.

If a tenant complies with the requirements of the CDC Order and provides a copy of the CDC Declaration Form required under the CDC Order to the Court, or if the landlord affidavit indicates that the landlord received a CDC Declaration Form from the tenant, or if the Court otherwise determines that the tenant has provided a CDC Declaration Form to the landlord, the following procedures will apply:

1. In cases at the Magisterial District Court, the action may be accepted for filing, but the case shall be stayed until after the expiration of the CDC Order. However, in order to give the parties an opportunity to also consider available rental assistance, the initial hearing date shall still be used to conduct a status conference rather than a hearing and the Emergency Rental Assistance Program or other programs shall be considered by the parties. Following this status conference, the matter shall be stayed until after the expiration of the CDC Order.

2. For cases in the Court of Common Pleas, the action may be accepted for filing, but the case shall be stayed until after the expiration of the CDC Order. 3. A Writ or Order of Possession shall not be issued and any previously issued Writ or Order of Possession shall be considered stayed and shall not be executed until after the expiration of the CDC Order. be found at http://www.pacourts.us/ assets/files/setting-901/file-9976.pdf?cb=fdaeb3. This Order shall become effective on March 1, 2021 and shall remain in effect until further Order of Court.

Accordingly, the Court extends its January 26, 2021 temporary amendment of its August 31, 2020 Emergency Operations Order with some modifications and it is hereby **ORDERED** that the following measures be taken pursuant to Pa.R.J.A. No. 1952(B)(2) effective Monday, March 1, 2021 through Friday, April 2, 2021:

Court of Common Pleas

During this period of time, all matters shall be conducted remotely via Advanced Communication Technology (ACT) and no in-person hearings or proceedings shall occur in any division of the Court of Common Pleas other than as set forth below. All proceedings that can be conducted remotely shall proceed as scheduled subject to the following provisions.

Postponements

• All proceedings scheduled on or prior to April 2, 2021 that cannot be conducted using ACT or in person, as permitted pursuant to this Order, shall be postponed to a date certain after April 2, 2021 pursuant to the procedures for each division.

• All published Civil Division trial lists continue to be suspended subject to the Order of September 17, 2020 (AD 185 of 2020) concerning non-jury trials and the Order of February 5, 2021 (AD 27 of 2021) concerning in-person jury trials.

• Recognizing that the September 4, 2020 Center for Disease Control and Prevention's Order temporarily halting certain evictions nationwide (CDC Order) has been extended through March 31, 2021, all Civil Division Orders of Court staying a case pursuant to the terms of the CDC Order are hereby extended through March 31, 2021.

• All in-person arbitration hearings are suspended through April 2, 2021. o All previously scheduled fully remote arbitration hearings conducted using ACT shall proceed as scheduled. If an in-person hearing has been suspended pursuant to this Order, the parties may request a fully remote arbitration hearing using ACT. The parties requesting a fully remote ACT arbitration hearing shall do so utilizing the forms, instructions and protocols found on the Court's website at https://www.alleghenycourts.us/civil/a rbitration.aspx. o If an arbitration hearing is continued pursuant to this Order and the parties do not seek a fully remote arbitration hearing, the Court will reschedule the arbitration and the Department of Court Records will send notice of the new arbitration hearing date to the parties.

ticipants appearing by ACT as possible, including witnesses and attorneys. No other Criminal Division hearings or proceedings shall be conducted in person.

• No jury trials, non-jury trials, or other proceedings which require the inperson testimony of out-of-state witnesses shall take place in any Division until after April 2, 2021.

• The Civil Division Arbitration Department will resume limited in-person arbitration hearings on April 5, 2021, employing all safety protocols as set forth in the Court's Amended Emergency Operations Plan Order of August 31, 2021.

• Pending further order of court, no jury trials shall take place until after April 2, 2021. The Court shall continue to evaluate the circumstances regarding the positive COVID-19 cases in Allegheny County to determine an appropriate time to resume jury trials.

All Court of Common Pleas facilities shall remain open to the public and open for case filings including, but not limited to:

• The Criminal Division Miscellaneous Motions Counter, Room 534 for acceptance of filings;

• The Formal Arraignment section, Room 519, for those defendants with a scheduled formal arraignment who have not waived their presence;

• The Civil Division Housing Court Help Desk for assistance to landlords and tenants;

• The Family Law Center for the filing of Petitions for Protection from Abuse (PFA) and entry of Temporary PFA Orders per the August 31, 2020 Emergency Operations Order.

Magisterial District Courts

The operations in the Magisterial District Courts are temporarily modified as follows:

• Summary Non-Traffic/Traffic proceedings scheduled during the period from March 1, 2021 through April 2, 2021, in which all parties agree and are able to conduct the proceeding using ACT, may be conducted remotely. If the proceedings cannot be conducted using ACT, the proceedings shall be postponed to a date certain after April 2, 2021. Special hardship requests by a defendant for an in-person hearing in a summary case may be granted at the discretion of the Magisterial District Judge, provided that all COVID-19 protocols, including occupancy restrictions in courtrooms and waiting rooms, are strictly followed.

• Commerical Landlord-Tenant proceedings may proceed as scheduled, with as many participants appearing by ACT as possible, including witnesses and attorneys. Participants who cannot appear by ACT are permitted to appear in person.

• Residential Landlord-Tenant proceedings shall be governed by a separate Order issued this same date.

• Civil proceedings scheduled during the period from March 1, 2021 through April 2, 2021, in which the defendant has notified the Court that they intend to defend the case pursuant to Pa.R.C.P.M.D.J. 304(4)(a), shall be postponed to a date certain after April 2, 2021.
